Međunarodno Trijenale tapiserije u organizaciji „Ateljea 61“ najveća je manifestacija tapiserijske umetnosti u nas. Šesto izdanje Trijena u Novom Sadu potvrda je vrhunskog profesionalizma jedinstvene ustanove za izradu umetničkih tapiserija i svedočanstvo o poziciji novosadskog Trijena u internacionalnim okvirima, između manifestacija sličnog karaktera. Kontinuirano, duže od pola veka, „Atelje 61“ potencira značaj tapiserijskog medija u vizuelnim umetnostima. Bogata izlagačka aktivnost u zemlji i inostranstvu, dodela nagrade autora koji su svojim umetničkim radom doprineli unapređenju ovog likovnog medija, bijenalno organizovanje međunarodne kolonije tapiserista i međunarodno Trijenale tapiserije – najobičniji i najzahtevniji program „Ateljea 61“, manifestacije su putem kojih se u ovoj ustanovi posvećeno, sa mnogo energije i znanja, radi na afirmaciji i popularizaciji tapiserijske umetnosti.

Prva trijenalna izložba jugoslovenske tapiserije održana je 2001. godine, a 2014. manifestacija je stekla internacionalni karakter. Iz godine u godinu, na Trijenalu „Ateljea 61“ učestvuje sve veći broj autora iz mnogih zemalja širom sveta, kao i brojni domaći umetnici, koji se izražavaju u mediju tapiserije. Prilikom selekcije radova za eksponaciju na šestoj trijenalnoj smotri, zahvaljujući velikom odzivu autora, Umetnički savet „Ateljea 61“ našao se pred zahtevnim zadatkom. Izabrano je 65 ostvarenja 57 umetnika iz 22 države Evrope, Severne i Južne Amerike. Autori izloženih dela su iz Argentine, Bosne i Hercegovine, Brazila, Bugarske, Danske, Francuske, Grčke, Hrvatske, Italije, Letonije, Litvanije, Nemačke, Norveške, Poljske, Portugalije, Rumunije, Rusije, Sjedinjenih Američkih Država, Slovačke, Srbije, Švajcarske i Velike Britanije. Veliki broj učesnika i izabranih radova svedoči o renomeu koji ova manifestacija uživa kod nas i u svetu. Po oceni stručnog žirija, najboljima se dodeljuju dve ravnopravne nagrade – za najbolje ostvarenje u domenu klasične tapiserije i za savremenih pristup tapiseriji.

Prema propozicijama Trijena, eksponati na šestoj smotri tapiserijske umetnosti izvedeni su u periodu 2015–2017. godine. Izložena ostvarenja pružaju uvid u deo savremenih umetničkih kretanja i aktualnih tendencija u istraživanju komunikacijskih vrednosti tapiserije. Autori su tapiseristi i likovni umetnici interdisciplinarnih interesovanja, različite generacijske pripadnosti, koji se u svom kreativnom radu služe najrazličitijim tehnikama. Izložena dela izvedena su ručnim tkanjem, klečanjem, čvorovanjem, slobodnim ručnim preplitanjem, ve-

zom, kombinovanim, slobodnim ili ličnim tekstilnim tehnikama. U realizaciji svojih ostvarenja, pored tradicionalnih materijala – vune, pamuka i kudelje, autori su primenili i druge, neuobičajene u klasičnoj tapiseriji – industrijski proizvedenu odeću, novinsku hartiju, vatelin, metalne žice, plastične i zlatne folije, kamen, drvo, ogledala, špenadle, fotografije, trake iz video kaseta i različite aplikacije. Pored klasičnih tapiserija, zastupljeni su prostorni objekti i skulpture od tekstila u kombinaciji sa drugim materijalima. Mnogi su autori pokazali sklonost ka istraživanju i eksperimentu u svojim kreativnim postupcima sa materijalima i tehnikama u procesu izvođenja. U ishodištu, konsekventno su zadржали osnovnu odliku tapiserije kao umetničke discipline u kojoj delo nastaje preplitanjem niti.

Šesto novosadsko Trijenale „Ateljea 61“ uzbudljiva je smotra tapiserijske umetnosti autora različitih umetničkih poetika i shvatanja ovog likovnog medija. Velike izložbe umetnosti međunarodnog karaktera uvek su poseban izazov, kako za umetnike i publiku, tako i za organizatore. Afirmisanjem tapiserijske umetnosti u tradicionalnom smislu, ali i modernim pristupom ovom likovnom mediju, podstičući istraživanja na polju tapiserijske umetnosti u domaćim i svetskim okvirima, „Atelje 61“ je šestim izdanjem novosadskog Trijenala tapiserije još jednom potvrdio svoju kompetentnost i autoritet.

The International Triennial of tapestry organised by the Atelier 61 is the biggest event of tapestry art in our country. The sixth Triennial exhibition in Novi Sad is the confirmation of true professionalism of our unique institution for making art tapestries and a testimonial to the international position of the Triennial in Novi Sad, among the events of similar character. Continuously, for more than half a century Atelier 61 emphasizes the importance of tapestry as a medium in visual arts. Through numerous exhibitions in the country and abroad, awards to the authors who have contributed with their art work in promoting this art media, biennial organisation of international colonies of tapestry artists and the international triennial tapestry being the most comprehensive and most demanding programmes of Atelier 61, through which, with extensive energy and great knowledge, we try to work on popularisation and affirmation of tapestry as an art form.

The first Triennial exhibition of Yugoslavian tapestry was held in 2001, and in 2014, the event has become international in character. Year after year, more and more artists from other countries around the world participate at the Triennial of Atelier 61, along with our very own artists, who express themselves through tapestry as a medium. While selecting works for the exhibition for the sixth Triennial, due to great response from the authors, the Arts Council of Atelier 61 has faced a difficult task. 67 works of art from 55 artists were chosen from 22 countries in Europe, North and South America. The authors of the exhibits are from Argentina, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Denmark, France, Greek, Croatia, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Germany, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, the United States of America, Slovakia, Serbia, Switzerland and Great Britain. A large number of participants and the exhibits is a testimony to the reputation of this event in our country as well as in the world. The jury will choose the best and the best will be awarded two equal awards - for the best work in the domain of classical tapestry and for the contemporary approach to tapestry.

According to the propositions of the Triennial, the exhibits on the sixth exhibition of tapestry art are performed in the period from 2015-2017. The exhibits give us an insight in a portion of contemporary art movement and real tendencies in the exploration of communicative values of tapestry as art. The authors are tapestry artists and artists of interdisci-

plinary interests, belonging to different generations, who use the most diverse techniques in their creative works. The exhibits are done in hand weaving, plain technique, macramé, free hand interlacing textile technique, embroidery, combined, free or personal textile techniques. While creating their works, besides traditional materials - wool, cotton and hemp, the authors have applied other, more unusual materials in classic art tapestry - industrially manufactured clothes, newspapers, vatelin (fabric used for the lining of jackets), metal wires, plastic and gold foil, rock, wood, mirrors, pins, photographs, video tapes and various appliqués. Besides classic tapestry, there are installations and sculptures made of textile in combination with other materials. Many authors have shown inclination towards exploration and experiments in their creation with materials and techniques in the process of making the art form. As a result, they have consequently retained the basic property of tapestry as an art discipline in which the work arises from the interlacing of thread.

The sixth Triennial of Atelier 61 in Novi Sad is a thrilling parade of art tapestry of different artistic poetics and understanding of tapestry as an art medium. Great exhibitions, international in character are always a special challenge, not only for the artists and the audience but for the organisers as well. By affirming tapestry art in the traditional sense, and also by modern approach to this fine art medium, encouraging research in the field of tapestry art in the domestic and world frames Atelier 61 has once again confirmed its competence and authority with the sixth issue of Triennial of tapestry in Novi Sad.

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Nagrade 5. trijenala tapiserije 2014.

Žiri medjunarodnog Petog trijenala tapiserije, u Novom Sadu, u internacionalnom sastavu dr Ivana Podnar iz Hrvatske, mr Mihaela Padeva iz Bugarske i mr Vera Markovic iz Srbije, imala je zadatak da dodeli dve ravnopravne nagrade za najbolja ostvarenja, s jedne strane u domenu klasicne, tradicionalne tapiserije, a s druge, za savremenu tapiseriju.

Prvogradjeni rad u klasicnoj tapisriji je rad BARBARE BURNS iz Amerike, pod nazivom „Revolucija“. Tapiserija se bazira na izrazito klasičnoj tehnici tapiserijskog tkanja, u kojoj autor koristi figuraciju kao tradicionalni modus umetničke komunikacije, motivom se zadržava na poznatom, dok je ideja revolucionarosti njen neoborivi istinski sadržaj. U svetu u kome su viđene mnogobrojne varijante revolucija, od političkih do umetničkih, sama ideja revolucionarnog dovodi u opasnost originalnost umetničkog rada. Međutim, Barbara Burns uspesno je redefinisala ovaj pojam koristeći upravo uobičajene kodove da bi stvorila vanstandardno značenje i otvorila pitanja koja, poput ženskog lika na tapiseriji, prevazilaze konvencionalne okvire. Revolucija apsolutno pulsira ispod površine savršene tehničke izrade i tera recipijenta da traži znakove koji unose nemir, a koji se prepoznavaju tek na drugi pogled, kroz intuiciju kojom postepeno nesvesno otkrivamo i sadržaj i formu. To su izgubljeni identiteti, depersonizovana lica i personifikovana ornamentika haljina koje odnose revolucionaru pobedu u konstrisanju našeg ja. Naslanjajući se na tradiciju ilustracija modnih časopisa, koji su odigrali važnu emancipatorsku ulogu modernog društva, američka umetnica u 21. veku ponovno stavlja u fokus temeljne probleme smisla istorijskih revolucija, povezujući univerzalnom niti dva sveta podjeljena okeanom, a koja bi se jednostavno mogla sažeti pitanjem – šta je nama revolucija dala?

Prvagrađeni rad u kategoriji savremene tapiserije, autora ZLATKA CVETKOVIĆA iz Srbije, pod nazivom „Madonna“ oslanja se na kulturnu memoriju, originalno povezujući lokalne specifičnosti i globalnu simboliku, od istorijskog vremena do savremene popularne kulture. Rad Madonna osvaja pažnju promatrača gotovo opasnom zavodljivošću koja je i Platona navela da umetnike izbaci iz svoje države. Umetnost kao senka senke, kao dvostruka varka sveta ideja, višestruko je vidljiva u ovom radu. Privid kao ključ čitanja smisla prepoznaće se na nekoliko nivoa: materijal koji i jeste i nije nit, ali i pitanje o kojoj je Madonna reč? Kojim se ikonama danas klanjam, onim hrišćanskim ili popkulturnim? Umetnik je otvorenost odgovora utkao kroz sam materijal audio trake na koju svako pojedinačno može snimiti onu simboliku koja odgovara njegovom pojmu Madonne. Odnos punog i praznog koji je dat samom tehnikom heklanja javlja se u fizičkoj materiji umetničkog predmeta, kao i u njegovoj jednako stvarnoj fluidnoj senki u pozadini, a može

se iščitavati i kao simbolička ispraznjenost odnosno ispunjenost ikona danas. Ova univerzalna pitanja su vrlo delikatno povezana sa lokalnom tradicijom heklnih predmeta kao prepoznatljivih dekorativnih elemenata gotovo svih kućnih enterijera naših krajeva, pri čemu umjetnik ukrasno / religijski predmet koristi kao povod za postavljanje pitanja šta zapravo čini auru umetničkog dela i religijskog obožavanja u savremennom društvu.

Ovogodišnje, Peto po redu, Trijenale pokazalo izrazitu heterogenost pristupa, stilova, tehnika i sadržaja, što je žiriranje učinilo posebno zanimljivim, ali je istovremeno i vrlo izazovnim zadatkom u prepoznavanju visokih umetničkih stavova u svim nivoima. Gotovo jednako heterogen žiri neobičnom je lakoćom uspostavio konsenzus oko nagrađenih radova koji su pokrenuli brojna važna pitanja o poziciji, značaju i značenju tekstilne umetnosti u savremenom kontekstu, kako u šarenom svetu , tako i u Srbiji.

Awards of the 5th triennial of tapestry 2014

The expert jury of the 5th Triennial of Tapestry in Novi Sad, consisting of the internationally established members starting with PhD Ivana Podnar from Croatia, MA Michaela Padeva from Bulgaria, and MA Vera Markovic from Serbia, had an assignment to award two equal prizes. One prize is for the best achievements in classical, traditional tapestry and the other one is for the best achievements in contemporary tapestry.

The first prize work in classical tapestry belongs to BARBARA BURNS from the USA, titled 'Revolution'. The tapestry is based on particularly classical weaving technique where the author uses figuration as a traditional mode of artistic communication, with the motifs belonging to the familiar, whereas the idea of revolution is its true, undeniable content. In the world that has already seen numerous variations of revolution, from political to artistic ones, the very idea of the revolution endangers the originality of the artistic work. However, Barbara Burns has successfully redefined this term using the exactly ordinary codes in order to create outstanding meaning and she has also asked the questions which, like the female image on the tapestry, overcome the conventional frames. The revolution is absolutely beating under the superbly, technically manufactured surface of the tapestry and it is urging the recipient to look for the signs that bring in the restlessness, and which can be seen only after the second examining, through the intuition that helps the recipient reveal both the form and the meaning gradually and unconsciously. Those are the lost identities, depersonalised faces and personified ornaments of the gowns that win the revolutionary victory in constructing of one's 'I'. Following the tradition of illustration of fashion magazines, which had an important, emancipating role in the modern society, American artist, once again, in the 21st century, puts the focus on fundamental problems of the meaning of historical revolutions, binding the two worlds separated by the ocean with the universal thread, and the problems could be simply put in one question - What has the revolution brought to us?

The first prize work in the contemporary tapestry category, the work of ZLATKO CVETKOVIC from Serbia, titled 'Madonna' relies on the cultural memory and binds in an genuine manner the local peculiarities and global symbolics, from ancient time until contemporary popular culture. 'Madonna' captures the viewer's attention with almost dangerous seductiveness that also led Plato to ban artists from his country. Art as a shadow of a shadow, as double trick of the world of ideas, can be seen in multiple ways in this work. Illusion, as the key to understanding the point, can be seen on several levels: the material which at the same time is and is not the thread, but also the question which Maddona is presented here? Which icons do we bow before, Christian

ones or those belonging to pop culture? The artist has intertwined the breadth of the answers through the material of cassette tape which anyone can use to record the symbolism which suits their understanding of which Madonna this is. The ratio of fulfilment and emptiness that is given by the crochet technique appears in physical matter of artistic object, as well as in equally real fluid shadow in the background, and it can be read as a symbolic emptiness or fulfilment of the icons today. These universal questions are delicately connected to local tradition of crocheted items as recognised, decorative elements in almost every home in our area, with the artist using the decorative/religious object as a reason to ask the questions what really makes the aura of an artistic work and religious worship in a contemporary society.

This year fifth Triennial showed strong heterogeneity in approaches, styles, techniques, contents, which made the jury's task of reaching the decisions more interesting, but at the same time more challenging to recognise high artistic attitudes at all levels. Almost equally heterogeneous jury made the consensus, unusually easy, regarding the awarded works which started numerous important questions about the position and the importance of textile art in a contemporary context, not just in vivid world, but in Serbia as well.
